

While attending sixth form at North Halifax Grammar School (NHGS), I continuously debated what to do with my life after graduation: pursue university or an apprenticeship. I decided to apply for both, but once I received the acceptance phone call for the Business and Supply Chain apprenticeship at GSK, I knew it was the right path and never looked back.

Over the next four years, I learned all areas of logistics in a manufacturing environment, including purchasing and supplying products that make a real difference to the world and patients' health. As I immersed myself in the pharmaceutical manufacturing world, I spent one day a week studying for a BSc in Professional Practice in Supply Chain Leadership, which was completely paid for, from university fees to a coffee between sessions.

Since graduating from my apprenticeship, I have moved into the role of Procurement Specialist. In this role, I engage with suppliers from around the world, implementing innovative projects to improve production performance, reduce our carbon footprint, and manage costs effectively.

My apprenticeship at GSK has not only allowed me to develop professionally but also personally. I moved out of my parents' home at 18 to the North East of England and had to fend for myself (and use a hoover for the first time). I was also able to buy my first house at 21, a milestone that would have been impossible for several years had I chosen the traditional university route.

1. GENERAL RESEARCH

Start by researching what apprenticeships are and the wide range available

2. SPECIFIC RESEARCH

Look on the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education (IfATE) website and search for apprenticeship standards using keywords that interest you, e.g. theatre, finance, sport, health:







3. VACANCIES RESEARCH

Look at current vacancies on the Government website, Find an Apprenticeship (FAA) to see what is available. Read the job adverts to help you know what employers are looking for. Create an account and set up alerts for new vacancies that fit your criteria.

4. EMPLOYER RESEARCH

Research employers that offer apprenticeships. Don't discount any companies without looking into them properly! If an employer you're interested in mentions knowledge, skills, qualities or experience they require, think about how you could show you meet their criteria, or what you could do now to ensure you do in the future.

Visit the employers' website and social media pages to find out more about what they do.

Find out where the position will be based and start to look at transport options. Could you get there everyday?

5. GET READY TO APPLY

It's never too early to start getting ready to apply for apprenticeships. Read up on the different processes so that you can be ready to apply when you see a vacancy that interests you.

Apprenticeship levels range from level 2 (intermediate) through to level 7 (master's level) in more than 1,500

There are four types of apprenticeship

- Intermediate (level 2)
- Advanced (level 3)

different job roles.

- Higher (levels 4 and above)
- Degree (levels 6 7)



Intermediate apprenticeships

Intermediate apprenticeships are typically considered to be the same level as five GCSE passes.

Intermediate apprenticeships are a fantastic way to get started with your career in an entry level role within an organisation.

Advanced apprenticeships

Advanced apprenticeships are considered to be the same level as two or three A level passes. Many individuals who have completed their A levels or other level 3 qualifications will undertake an advanced apprenticeship as it will enable them to gain experience in the workplace and undertake a variety of different tasks.

Amazîng

Higher apprenticeships

Higher apprenticeships include qualifications at levels 4 and above. They can be suitable for those looking to progress from level 3 qualifications, including advanced apprenticeships and T Levels

Degree apprenticeships

Degree apprenticeships are offered by universities and other higher education providers. They contain either a full degree or degree-level qualification and go up to master's level (which is postgraduate).

Which level is right for you?

The type of apprenticeship undertaken will depend on both the needs of the employer and the job role as well as the apprentice, their previous experience and qualifications held.

Your training provider will also be able to quide you as to the most appropriate level for you.

Level 3 advanced - same as 2 or 3 A Levels

Level 4+ Higher in between A Levels and Degree
